Board of Directors UKDHC (at least 3 posts)

UKDHC has at least three vacancies on our Board of Directors. These are voluntary, unpaid positions with significant potential for improving digital skills and the implementation of digital technology in both the health and social care arena and thus improving the efficiency and effectiveness of care.

We welcome applications from informaticians, healthcare professionals (nurses, doctors, dentists, allied health professionals, pharmacists and those working in social services) with an interest in digital health, University/Academics, IT professionals working in the field and people with relevant leadership, team management, legal and communication skills.

This is a voluntary, unpaid position with significant potential. As a Director you will:

1. Be responsible for the running of the organisation and ensuring it conforms to “Community Interest Company” guidelines.
2. Empower Healthcare Professionals by exploring and promoting cutting-edge digital tools and concepts as well as data-driven insights.
3. Transform Patient Care by advocating for improved care through digital health in order to drive better outcomes.
4. Promote Sustainable Health and Care by working with others to create a health and care system that is fit for the future.
5. Foster Innovation by helping to cultivate innovation and excellence within the health and care sector.

We particularly welcome applications from people from minoritised backgrounds who are currently under-represented within the organisation.

Commitment required – 1) Attendance at least 75% of Board of Directors meetings held virtually from 18.00 to 19.30 usually on Tuesday evenings (4x per year)

2) Attendance at least 75% of Executive Committee meetings held virtually from 18.00 to 19.30 usually on Tuesday evenings (4x per year)

3) Attendance at UKDHC Annual Scientific Conference (virtual all-day 8th October 2025).

Applicants may also be considered for Non-Executive Director appointments. Non-Executive Directors will not be required to fulfil (2) & (3) above but would be welcome to do so.
